KING – As our nation continues to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Vietnam War, the Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs and the Wisconsin Veterans Home at King would like to recognize the 210 Vietnam and Vietnam-era veterans who make their home at King.

In recognition of these veterans, a formal program will take place in Ainsworth Hall at 9:30 am. Tuesday, March 29. Featured speakers will be WDVA Secretary John A. Scocos and American Legion – Department of Wisconsin Commander Dale Oatman who is a Vietnam veteran, and Vietnam Veteran and member of King, Dennis Kinney.

In addition to a formal program, Vietnam Veterans of America Wisconsin State President Richard Lindbeck and his team will be hosting an educational opportunity on Agent Orange from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. in the Marden Center multi-purpose room, also on the King campus.

The President of the United States has declared May 28, 2012, through Nov. 11, 2025, as the Commemoration of the 50th Anniversary of the Vietnam War. WDVA is Wisconsin's lead agency in commemorating the Vietnam war and holding special recognition events during the commemoration period.
