SUBJECT: Wisconsin Veteran Homes Care Rates, Effective January 1, 2013

Effective January 1, 2013, the rates for skilled nursing care and assisted living care are adjusted for the Wisconsin Veterans Homes at King and Union Grove. Members at the homes received notice of the change in care charges on or before December 1. Rates for the King and Union Grove homes are provided for your information on the attached WDVA 4020A (11/12) form.

The Wisconsin Veterans Homes are required by law to establish rates based on projected costs. Twice each year, in January and July, rates may be adjusted to reflect the cost of our operations. The calculation is based on the costs we incur or expect to incur in the following year. These calculations will be reviewed and rates may be adjusted in July.

ADMISSION AGREEMENT — ATTACHMENT A — DAILY RATES

SUMMARY:

- Per Chapter VA 6.01 (16) Wisconsin Administrative Code, the WDVA must adjust care rates to cover the cost of operations.
 - The calculation is based on the costs incurred currently and the expected costs for the following year.
 - Inclusion of projected costs in the calculation is required by code.
 - The calculation determines what the cost of care needs to be to break even based on the current approved budget for the facility.
- Twice each year (January 1st and July 1st) the calculation is reviewed.
- A written notice to members/legal representatives is provided a minimum of thirty (30) days prior to the change.
- Daily rate information is provided to the prospective member/legal representative on application for admission and at the time of admission.
- Member absence from the Wisconsin Veterans Home past midnight will be counted as a furlough day.
- **Qualified veterans with a permanent service-connected disability rating of 70% or higher are entitled to cost-free care.**

SKILLED NURSING FACILITIES PRIVATE PAY DAILY RATES (Rates Effective Since January 1, 2013)

Each Veterans Home receives a daily offset (VA per diem) from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs(USDVA), to help cover the cost of care for each veteran member. Effective October 1, 2012, the amount of the per diem for nursing care, as set by the USDVA, is \$97.07.

Daily care rates continue to be charged to maintain residency when a member is out of the facility. After 15 nights, a member may be discharged unless they request to maintain their residency at the full care rate.

Out of facility, other than hospital stay:

Veterans: Federal VA will continue the \$97.07 nursing offset for the first 12 nights of absence **per calendar year**. The full care rate is charged beginning with day 13.

Non-veterans: Full care rate is charged for entire absence.

Out of facility, hospital stay:

Veterans: Federal VA will continue the \$97.07 nursing offset for the first 10 **consecutive nights of each hospital stay**. The full care rate is charged for day 11 through day 15.

Non-veterans: Full care rate is charged for the first 15 days of each hospital stay.

SKILLED NURSING FACILITIES PRIVATE PAY DAILY RATES

(Rates Effective Since January 1, 2013)

Each Veterans Home receives a daily offset (VA per diem) from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs (USDVA), to help cover the cost of care for each veteran member. Effective October 1, 2012, the amount for nursing home care, as set by the USDVA, is \$97.07.

Veterans: Federal VA will continue the \$97.07 nursing offset for the first 12 nights of absence **per calendar year**. The full care rate is charged beginning with day 13.

Non-veterans: Full care rate is charged for entire absence.

Out of facility, hospital stay:

Veterans: Federal VA will continue the \$97.07 nursing offset for the first 10 **consecutive nights of each hospital stay**. The full care rate is charged for day 11 through day 15.

Non-veterans: Full care rate is charged for the first 15 days of each hospital stay.

UNION GROVE ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES DAILY RATES

(Rates Effective Since January 1, 2013)

Each VeteransHome receives a daily offset (VA per diem) from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs (USDVA), to help cover the cost of care for each veteran member. Effective October 1, 2012, the amount for domiciliary care, as set by the USDVA, is \$41.90.

BED HOLD RATE (rate charged to members who are out of the facility)

- Veterans:**
- Non-VA hospital stays not exceeding 96 hours are billed at the veteran rate
 - Non-VA hospital stays exceeding 96 hours are billed at the non-veteran rate retroactive to day 1
 - VA hospital stays will be billed at the non-veteran rate effective day 1
 - All other absences not exceeding 96 hours are billed at the veteran rate
 - All other absences exceeding 96 hours are billed at the non-veteran rate retroactive to day 1

Non-Veterans: All absences are billed at the non-veteran rate.
